Amplified Leaders

Amplified Leaders is an effort by Global Partners (the mission arm of the Wesleyan Church) to train indigenous pastors all around the world. Of the 4,000+ Wesleyan pastors who live outside North America, only one in three is trained. Amplified Leaders provides the financial support and distance learning programs that make training possible in regions where cost and travel barriers would otherwise be prohibitive. Through Amplified Leaders, so far more than 350 Wesleyan pastors have been funded toward ordination in Asia, Africa, and Central America.
