

Mercy Ships Michael and Heather Drown

HWC supports Mercy Ships, an International Christian organization that brings hope and healing to the world's forgotten poor. Mercy Ships operates two "floating hospitals" off the coasts of Africa, providing health

and dental care to people with no other access to life-saving procedures. Heather works in administration and Michael is an engineer responsible for Mercy Ships' technology and logistics. Since Mercy Ships founding in 1978, volunteer professionals from 60 nations have performed more than 105,000 surgeries and 488,000 dental procedures aboard the vessels. While docked, the ships also serve as a training center for local health care workers, strengthening the host country's health care system in everything from anesthesia and trauma care to infection control. Michael Drown is the son of former Hayward Wesleyan pastor Ben Drown. Heather and Michael have an adult son, Jason. Children attending this year's Vacation Bible School at HWC will raise funds for Mercy Ships through their annual Penny Wars competition.
