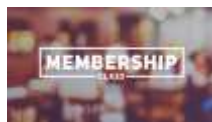

Guatemala Summer Mission Team HWC is sending a team of twenty-four people to Guatemala July 31- August 8. They will serve with *Impacto*, a Christian ministry bringing new life in Christ to impoverished Mayan communities. The 9 medical

professionals, 5 other adults and 11 youth helpers on the team will bring a mobile medical clinic serving 500 families, and work with children and seniors at nutrition programs. (Guatemala has the highest rates of malnutrition in Central America.) The team is raising funds for travel costs and the medications and supplies they'll need.
